Available since version: **1.8.3**

This function allows you to check whether application with given application data exists.

Parameters

Parameter	Type	Optional	Description	Details
nodeids	<i>array</i>	yes	List of node IDs where to search for given application	
name	<i>string</i>	No	Application name	
hostid	<i>string</i>	yes	Host ID	
host	<i>string</i>	yes	Host name	

Returns

Parameter	Description
result	Operation successful. Result will contain boolean variable.
error	In case of any errors

Example

Check if application with name "OS" exists for host "Windows-Server"

    "host": "Windows-Server",
    "name": "OS"
  },
  "auth": "3a57200802b24cda67c4e4010b50c065",
  "id": 2
}
```

Application exists:

  "id": 2
}
```
